2) Minutes of the last meetings:- It was agreed to defer this item to the next meeting.

3) Matters arising:- It was agreed to defer this item to the next meeting.

4) Financial Matters:- a) The financial report for 2003/2004 had already been circulated and studied. The Clerk pointed out that the value of the items listed in the supporting statement had been increased to the replacement and insurance values. Mrs Shirley Smith proposed that the financial report be accepted and Mr Oliver Hitchcock seconded this proposal. All were in favour.

b) CDC Blowers Contracting have cut the grass in the Parish Park 3 times to 1^{st} June 2004. The Clerk has issued a cheque to CDC Blowers Contracting for £105.75 on 11^{th} June to cover this work. Mrs Shirley Smith proposed that this was in order and Mr Peter Robinson seconded this proposal. All were in favour.

c) The Clerk has issued a cheque for \pounds 470 to Art Founders Ltd on 11^{th} June as a deposit for the casting of the village sign. Mr Jeremy Holland-Howes proposed that this was in order and Mr Oliver Hitchcock seconded this proposal. All were in favour.

Mrs Jan Donegan proposed that the Clerk could pay the balance of ± 470 for the village sign plus the estimated cost of ± 50 for having an acid etched primer coat put on the sign. Mr Peter Robinson seconded this proposal and all were in favour.

6) Any Other Business:- The Chairman, Mrs Eleanor Berwick, informed the members that she had decided to stand down as Chairman for personal reasons but wished to stay on as a member of the Council.
